Rules and Regulations

1. For horse show purposes, the age of an exhibitor will be considered as of December 1, 2009.
2. All exhibitors must appear in proper attire.
3. All riders cannot ride anywhere on the showgrounds without wearing protective headgear passing ASTM-SEI standards. Harnesses must be secured and if headgear has a brim it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until their headgear is properly in place.
4. Management reserves the right to change the location of any class if necessary and to cancel or combine any classes if entries so warrant.
5. NO person will be allowed in the ring during judging unless on official business.
6. The State of Maryland requires that all horses and ponies must be in possession of a current negative Coggins Certificate taken within 12 months.
7. All ponies must have a current measurement card or be measured at the show.
8. Please - No Dogs Allowed.
9. Stallions are not permitted at all BCHSA shows.
10. No numbers will be issued without a signed blank check and signed entry form. Junior rider entries must be signed by an adult.
11. Three entries needed to fill a performance class. Small-Medium ponies will be split if there are 6 in each section.
12. The BCHSA and the show committee of Country Hill Farm will assume no responsibility, is not liable for any injury to person or to any horse at any time, which includes going to, coming from and in the ring. Neither will it be responsible for vehicles or articles that may be lost or damaged. All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agent's properties on the show grounds.
13. Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded in all divisions.
14. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.

The Country Hill Farm Horse Show is operated in accordance with the current rules of the Baltimore County Horse Show Association Inc. By entering this competition, and signing the entry form, the exhibitor agrees to be subject to the Baltimore County Horse Show Association Rules, the prize list and the local rules of the competition.

Lead Line Division - Open to children 4 years and under and 5-7 years of age as of December 1, 2009. Riders may not cross enter into any other pointed division at the same show. Mounts may not exceed 14.2 hands. Pony to be judged 50% on suitability to rider. Rider to be judged on hands, seat, and suitability of mount. To be shown both ways of the ring.

Class 1 - Lead Line Under 4 Years

Class 2 - Lead Line Walk Under 4 Years - Riders may be escorted without penalty as long as the pony or rider is not touched.

Class 3 - Lead Line 5-7 Years

Class 4 - Lead Line Walk 5-7 Years - Riders may be escorted without penalty as long as the pony or rider is not touched.

Mini Short Stirrup Division - Open to children 10 years of age and under as of December 1, 2009. Riders may not cross enter in any other division at the same show. Mounts not to exceed 14.2 hands.

Class 5 - Mini Short Stirrup Walk (Equitation) - To be judged at a walk both ways of the ring. To be judged on rider's hands, seat, guidance, control and suitability of mount.

Class 6 - Mini Short Stirrup Walk-Trot (Equitation) - To be judged at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. To be judged on rider's hands, seat, guidance, control and suitability of mount.

Class 7 - Mini Short Stirrup Walk-Trot (Pony) - To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. To be judged on suitability of mount to be a Mini Short Stirrup pony. Ponies manners are to be emphasized.

Class 8 - Mini Short Stirrup Crossrails Over Fences - To be shown over four 12" crossrails around the outside of the ring at the trot or canter, rider's preference and not to be penalized.

Short Stirrup Equitation Division - Open to riders 10 years of age and under as of December 1, 2009. Riders in this division may cross enter into the Short Stirrup Hunter division only. Mounts may not exceed 14.2 hands. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, control and suitability of mount. Martingales are prohibited in the flat phase of the division.

Class 9 - Short Stirrup Equitation Walk-Trot - To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring; to back easily and stand quietly.

Class 10 - Short Stirrup Equitation Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to back easily and stand quietly.

Class 11 - Short Stirrup Equitation Over Fences - To be shown over a minimum of 6 fences not to exceed 18" in height.

Short Stirrup Hunter Division - Open to riders 10 years of age and under as of December 1, 2009. Open to ponies 14.2 hands and under. Ponies are allowed to cross enter into any class where eligible. Riders may only cross enter into the Short Stirrup Equitation division. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Class 12 - Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences not to exceed 2'.

Class 13 - Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences not to exceed 2'.

Class 14 - Short Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter; to back easily and stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Long Stirrup Equitation Division - Open to senior and junior members over 10 years of age as of December 1, 2009. Riders in this division may cross enter into the Long Stirrup Hunter division only. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, control and suitability of mount. Martingales are prohibited in the flat phase of the division.

Class 15 - Long Stirrup Equitation Walk-Trot - To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring; to back easily and stand quietly.

Class 16 - Long Stirrup Equitation Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to back easily and stand quietly.

Class 17 - Long Stirrup Equitation Over Fences - To be shown over a minimum of 6 fences not to exceed 18" in height.

Long Stirrup Hunter Division - Open to senior and junior members over 10 years of age and under as of December 1, 2009. Open to ponies and horses. Horses and ponies are allowed to cross enter into any class where eligible. Riders may only cross enter into the Long Stirrup Equitation division. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Class 18 - Long Stirrup Hunter Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences not to exceed 2'.

Class 19 - Long Stirrup Hunter Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences not to exceed 2'.

Class 20 - Long Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter; to back easily and stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Small/Medium Pleasure Pony Division - Open to Junior riders on ponies 13.2 hands and under. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Extreme speed shall be penalized. Martingales are prohibited in all pleasure classes.

- Class 21 - Small/Medium Pleasure Pony Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'
- Class 22 - Small/Medium Pleasure Pony Combination Hack - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter on a light rein both ways of the ring; to back easily and stand quietly. At least 8 riders, if available, will be asked to jump 2 fences at 2' in height.
- Class 23 - Small/Medium Pleasure Pony Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter on a light rein both ways of the ring; to back easily and stand quietly. Other tests may be required at the judge's discretion.

Large Pleasure Pony Division - Open to Junior riders on ponies over 13.2 but not to exceed 14.2 hands. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Extreme speed shall be penalized. Martingales are prohibited in all pleasure classes.

- Class 24 - Large Pleasure Pony Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'
- Class 25 - Large Pleasure Pony Combination Hack - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter on a light rein both ways of the ring; to back easily and stand quietly. At least 8 riders, if available, will be asked to jump 2 fences at 2' in height.
- Class 26 - Large Pleasure Pony Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter on a light rein both ways of the ring; to back easily and stand quietly. Other tests may be required at the judge's discretion.

Low Small/Medium Pony Hunter Division - Open to Junior riders on ponies 13.2 hands and under. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

- Class 28 - Low Small/Medium Pony Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'
- Class 29 - Low Small/Medium Pony Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'
- Class 30 - Low Small/Medium Pony Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Low Large Pony Hunter Division - Open to Junior riders on ponies over 13.2 hands but not to exceed 14.2 hands. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

- Class 31 - Low Large Pony Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6"
- Class 32 - Low Large Pony Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6"
- Class 33 - Low Large Pony Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Equitation Under 14 Division - Open to riders under 14 years of age as of December 1, 2009. To be judged on hands, seat, general position, and control. At the discretion of the judge, other tests may be required.

- Class 34 - Equitation U/14 Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences - 2', 2'3" or 2'6", rider's preference.
- Class 35 - Equitation U/14 Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales are prohibited.

Equitation 14-17 Division - Open to riders who have reached their 14 but not their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2009. To be judged on hands, seat, general position, and control. At the discretion of the judge, other tests may be required.

- Class 36 - Equitation 14-17 Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6" or 3' in height, rider's preference.
- Class 37 - Equitation 14-17 Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales are prohibited.

BCHSA Junior Medal - Rider must be a BCHSA member to compete. The same horse/pony must be shown in all phases of the class. Martingales are not permitted in the under saddle phase of the class. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control throughout. At the discretion of the judge, additional tests may be required. At least 4 riders must complete the course.

- Class 38 - BCHSA Junior Medal - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences - 2'3", 2'6", 2'9" or 3', rider's preference. The judge will then select 1/4 of the class, but not less than 6 riders, if available, to show at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring.

Small/Medium Pony Hunter Division - Open to Junior riders on ponies 13.2 hands and under. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Small ponies jump 2'3"; Medium ponies jump 2'6".

- Class 39 - Small/Medium Pony Hunter Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences.
- Class 40 - Small/Medium Pony Hunter Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences.
- Class 41 - Small/Medium Pony Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Large Pony Hunter Division - Open to Junior riders on ponies over 13.2 hands but not to exceed 14.2 hands. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Class 42 - Large Pony Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'9"

Class 43 - Large Pony Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'9"

Class 44 - Large Pony Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Hopeful Hunter Division - Open to horses and ponies. Adults may ride ponies. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Class 45 - Hopeful Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'-2'3"

Class 46 - Hopeful Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'-2'3"

Class 47 - Hopeful Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Pleasure Horse Division - Open to horses. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Extreme speed shall be penalized. Martingales are prohibited in all pleasure classes.

Class 48 - Pleasure Horse Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences 2'6"

Class 49 - Pleasure Horse Combination Hack - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter on a light rein both ways of the ring; to back easily and stand quietly. At least 8 riders, if available, will be asked to jump 2 fences at 2'6" in height.

Class 50 - Pleasure Horse Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter on a light rein both ways of the ring; to back easily and stand quietly. Other tests may be required at the judge's discretion.

Low Hunter Division - Open to horses. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Class 51 - Low Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6"

Class 52 - Low Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6"

Class 53 - Low Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Children's Hunter Division - Open to Junior exhibitors on horses. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Class 54 - Children's Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6"

Class 55 - Children's Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6"

Class 56 - Children's Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Equitation Under 14 Division - Open to riders under 14 years of age as of December 1, 2009. To be judged on hands, seat, general position, and control. At the discretion of the judge, other tests may be required.

Class 58 - Equitation U/14 Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences - 2, 2'3" or 2'6", rider's preference.

Class 59 - Equitation U/14 Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales are prohibited.

Equitation 14-17 Division - Open to riders who have reached their 14 but not their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2009. To be judged on hands, seat, general position, and control. At the discretion of the judge, other tests may be required.

Class 60 - Equitation 14-17 Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6" or 3' in height, rider's preference.

Class 61 - Equitation 14-17 Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales are prohibited.

BCHSA Junior Medal - Rider must be a BCHSA member to compete. The same horse must be shown in all phases of the class. Martingales are not permitted in the under saddle phase of the class. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control throughout. At the discretion of the judge, additional tests may be required. At least 4 riders must complete the course.

Class 62 - BCHSA Junior Medal - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences - 2'3", 2'6", 2'9" or 3', rider's preference. The judge will then select 1/4 of the class, but not less than 6 riders, if available, to show at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring.

Adult Equitation Division - Open to Adult riders who are eligible to hold a USEF Amateur card. To be judged on hands, seat, general position, and control. At the discretion of the judge, other tests may be required.

Class 63 - Adult Equitation Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6" or 3', rider's preference.

Class 64 - Adult Equitation Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales are prohibited.

BCHSA Adult Medal - Rider must be a BCHSA member to compete. The same horse must be shown in all phases of the class. Martingales are not permitted in the under saddle phase of the class. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control throughout. At the discretion of the judge, additional tests may be required. At least 4 riders must complete the course.

Class 65 - BCHSA Adult Medal - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6" or 3', rider's preference. The judge will then select 1/4 of the class, but not less than 6 riders, if available, to show at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring.

Low Adult Amateur Hunter Division - Open to Senior exhibitors on horses. Riders in this division must be eligible to hold a USEF Amateur card. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Class 66 - Low Adult Amateur Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6"

Class 67 - Low Adult Amateur Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 2'6"

Class 68 - Low Adult Amateur Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Adult Amateur Hunter Division - Open to Senior exhibitors on horses. Riders in this division must be eligible to hold a USEF Amateur card. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Class 69 - Adult Amateur Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 3'

Class 70 - Adult Amateur Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 3'

Class 71 - Adult Amateur Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Junior Hunter Division - Open to Junior exhibitors on horses. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Class 72 - Junior Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 3'

Class 73 - Junior Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences. Fences - 3'

Class 74 - Junior Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; to stand quietly. Martingales are prohibited.

Open Hunter Division - Open to horses. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Class 78 - Green Hunter Over Fences - To be shown in the ring over 8 fences. Fences - First year - 3'; second year - 3'3"

Directions

From Route 695 (Baltimore Beltway): Take I-795 (Northwest Expressway) North. Drive 9.5 miles and take Route 140 North toward Westminster. Drive 13 miles and take Route 27 East toward Manchester. Drive 2 miles and turn right on Route 482 toward Hampstead. Drive .7 miles and turn left onto Leisters Church Road. Farm is on the right.

From Gaithersburg: Take Route 27 toward Damascus. Drive 17 miles and pass straight through Westminster. Cross under Route 140 and drive 2 miles. Turn right onto Route 482 toward Hampstead. Drive .7 miles and turn left onto Leisters Church Road. Farm is on the right.

From Hanover: Take Route 30 South to Manchester. Turn right on Route 27 and go 5.2 miles. Turn left on Old Manchester Road and left on Leisters Church Road. Farm is on the left.
