Federation Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees, and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the Country Hill Farm Horse Show (the "competition"). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film news media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Rules and Regulations

1. Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Equestrian rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith: *Life, Senior Active and Junior Active Members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30.00 non-member registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) Leadline; 2) Exhibitions; 3) Games and Races; 4) Classes for 4-H members; 5) Walk Trot and Academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF Introductory Level Tests, Pas De Deux and Quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA Beginner Novice division, and 11) Assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.*
2. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept, conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.
3. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show, the Country Hill Farm, its directors and employees, and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise.
4. The management reserves the right to interpret all questions regarding the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final.
5. In the event of cancellation of classes due to severe weather or other emergency, refund of all entry fees will be made to exhibitors.
6. Entries must be received by **November 29, 2011** to be considered timely.
7. Please mail your pre-entry as soon as possible. There is no fee to scratch. Post entries will be charged \$15.00 additional. Please, no phone entries.
8. All exhibitors must wear protective headgear at all times when mounted on the show grounds.
9. Prize money will be applied to your bill. Any prize money not applied to the bill, or over the amount of the bill, will be payable to the owner, unless otherwise stated. Please allow one-half hour for processing.
10. All Pony and Junior Hunters must show a current USEF measurement card. All Amateur riders must present their cards before numbers may be picked up.
11. The State of Maryland requires the show to possess a copy of a negative Coggins Certificate from every horse on the show grounds. The Coggins Certificate must be presented at the horse show office before numbers can be picked up.

12. The official veterinarian will be available to conduct measurements as follows:
 Saturday, December 3, 2011 - 9:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m.
 Sunday, December 4, 2011 - 8:00 a.m. - 8:30 a.m.
 If the veterinarian is required to measure at any time other than as stated above, the owner is responsible for paying veterinarian fees.
13. Entry forms must be filled out completely, including all classes or divisions entered, signatures, ID numbers, and organization or membership numbers before numbers can be issued. Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agents in preparation of their entry form. **An Open Check is required before numbers can be picked up.**
14. Please.... no dogs allowed.
15. Poling and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets are prohibited. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets and/or who, on the opinion of the judges or committee, uses their whip or spurs in an excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a 24 hours period, and will forfeit entries for that class.
16. SCHOOLING: Schooling over fences will be allowed until 7:30 a.m.
17. Limited number of permanent stalls with doors may be available. Call Country Hill Farm for information.
18. SCRATCHES: Please take care of ðClass Addsð and ðClass Scratchesð at least one hour before the start of the division. A form will be available at the Horse Show Office.
19. A processing fee of \$50.00 plus collection fees will be charged for all nonnegotiable checks.
20. All hunter classes will be judged on performance, manners, soundness and way of going. A dotted line may be used in all classes.
21. An office fee of \$20.00 will be assessed all entries.
22. FOOTING: Indoor Arena - 110øx 200ø- sand footing

In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Open to Junior riders on a pony and jump eight fences of hunter type with or without wings.
