Division Descriptions

Hopeful Hunter - Open to horses and ponies (adults may ride ponies). Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 2' or 2'6" in height.

Schooling Hunter - Open to horses and ponies (adults may ride ponies). Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 2'9" in height.

Special Hunter - Open to horses and ponies (adults may ride ponies). Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 3' in height.

Open Hunter - Open to horses. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 3'3" in height.

Children/Adult Hunter - Open to horses and riders 17 years of age and under or Adult Amateurs. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 2'6" or 3' in height. (Will be split if entries warrant).

Children Hunter Pony - Open to ponies and riders 17 years of age and under. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 2' in height.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Open to riders 11 years of age and under. Judged on hands, seat, legs, general position and control of mount.

Crossrail Hunter - Open to horses and ponies. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 18" in height. Simple lead changes will not be penalized.

Rules and Regulations

1. All riders are required to wear protective headgear when mounted.
2. Proper riding attire (boots and breeches) is required.
3. Classes may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the management and the show committee.
4. All entrants must sign a release form before showing. Juniors 18 years of age and under must have an adult sign.
5. Proof of negative Coggins dated within 12 months of the show date.
6. Three entries are necessary to fill a performance class.
7. A Junior rider is under 18 years of age as of December 1st.
8. All entries will be judged on soundness upon entering the ring and must trot at some point before jumping the course.
9. Schooling will be permitted until 7:45 a.m.
10. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
11. Championship and Reserve Champion in all divisions.
12. All classes will be in accordance with USEF when possible. Should a question arise that is not covered by the rules, the same will be referred to the Show Committee whose decision is final.
13. The Show Committee reserves the right to decline any entry, to return any entry fees before or during the show, without being liable for damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to judges or officials on the part of the owner, rider, trainer, or groom shall disqualify the entry and the owner shall forfeit entry and other fees.
14. Limited water on the grounds.
15. Delicious food available on the showgrounds.
16. \$14.00 per class.
