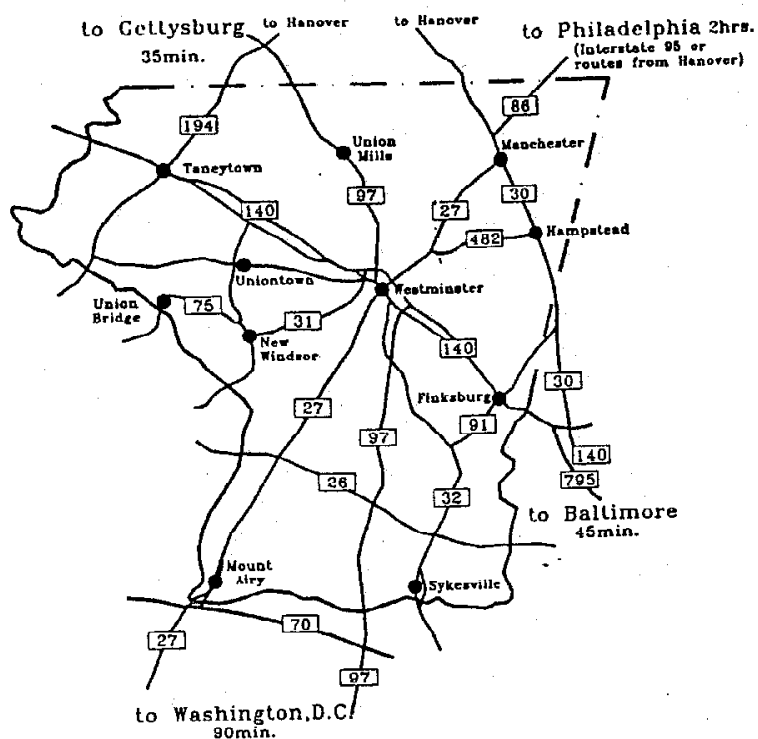


Directions

DIVISION DESCRIPTION

Lead Line - Open to riders 7 years of age and under. Judged 50% on child's hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability. May be asked to drop and pick up stirrups and reins. May compete in Mini Short Stirrup Division only.

Mini Short Stirrup - Open to riders 9 years of age and under. Judged on hands, seat, legs, general position, and control of mount. May cross enter in Lead Line Division only.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Open to riders 11 years of age and under. Judged on hands, seat, legs, general position and control of mount. May compete in Crossrail Hunter and Hopeful Hunter divisions.

Long Stirrup Equitation - Open to riders 12-17 years of age. Judged on hands, seat, legs, general position and control of mount. May compete in Crossrail Hunter and Hopeful Hunter divisions.

Beginner Adult Equitation - Open to adults. Judged on hands, seat, legs, general position and control of mount. May compete in Crossrail Hunter and Hopeful Hunter divisions.

Crossrail Hunter - Open to horses and ponies. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 18ö in height. Trot or canter fences. Simple lead changes will not be penalized.

Hopeful Hunter - Open to horses and ponies. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 2øin height.

Children Hunter Pony - Open to ponies 14.2 hands and under and riders 17 years of age and under. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences - 2øor 2øö.

Open Equitation - Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders. Judged on hands, seat, legs, general position and control of mount. Fences - 2-6ö or 2øö in height.

Schooling Hunter - Open to horses. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 2øö in height.

Special Hunter - Open to horses. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 2øö in height.

Children/Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to horses and riders 17 years of age and under or Adult Amateurs. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 2øö-3øin height.

Open Hunter - Open to horses. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 3øin height.

Rules and Regulations

1. All riders are required to wear protective headgear when mounted.
2. Proper riding attire (Boots and Breeches) is required. Coats are required for equitation classes.
3. Classes may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the management and the show committee.
4. All entrants must sign a release form before showing. Juniors 18 years of age and under must have an adult sign.
5. Proof of negative coggins dated within 12 months of the show date.
6. Three entries are necessary to fill a performance class.
7. A Junior Rider is a rider under 18 years of age as of December 1st.
8. All ponies are to be ridden by a Junior (except in Hopeful Hunter).
9. All entries will be judged on soundness upon entering the ring, and must trot at some point before jumping the course.
10. Schooling will be permitted until 8:15 a.m.
11. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
12. Championship and Reserve Champion in all divisions.
13. All classes will be in accordance with USEF when possible. Should a question arise that is not covered by the rules, the same will be referred to the Show Committee whose decision is final.
14. Scratches for a refund must be made before the class begins.
15. The Show Committee reserves the right to decline any entry, to return any entry fees before or during the show, without being liable for damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to judges or officials on the part of the owner, rider, trainer, or groom shall disqualify the entry and the owner shall forfeit entry and other fees.
16. Limited water on the grounds.
17. Delicious food available on the showgrounds.
18. \$15.00 per class
